#### The Fine Print:

Perio in the Peninsula Paint a Paddle Contest supports the ALS Society through funds raised at auction. This contest is open to persons over the age of 18. Parents or guardians may enter on behalf of their youth at their discretion. Each entry is subject to a \$39.82 (plus HST) entry fee which covers contest administration and raw paddle provided with your entry. Paddles may be purchased and returned completed at the office of Dr. Peter C. Fritz. Paddles purchased are intended for art and not for use in water.

#### PRIZES:

This contest will have a minimum 1 prize for every 20 paddles returned for auction. The number of eligible entries received by the contest closing date will determine the odds of winning a prize. Prizes must be accepted as awarded, have no cash equivalent and are not transferable or refundable. Prizes will be awarded on the day of the live paddle auction.

## WINNER SELECTION PROCESS:

Paddles that are received back before contest closing date of March 4, 2020 will be entered into our charity fundraising auction and are eligible for prizes. Paddles that receive the highest value auction bids by the end of the auction will be awarded prizes. In the event that the contest sponsors are unable to notify the selected entrant within 14 days of the draw, that selected entry may be disqualified and an alternate winner will be selected from among all remaining eligible entries.

#### LIABILITY:

By participating in this program, all participants and award winners agree that Perio in the Peninsula and its partnerships and affiliates and each of such entities respective directors and employees are not responsible or liable for any injury, loss illness, litigation or damage that may occur from participation in the promotion or acceptance, possession, use or misuse of prizes. In the event that any dispute arises regarding the meaning or interpretation of these official rules, participants agree that the dispute shall be resolved by applying the laws of Ontario and that it shall be resolved by and within the courts of that province.

## **ENTRANTS AGREE:**

By entering this contest, entrants agree to be governed by these rules, and, if requested, agree to have their name and/or photograph used without compensation for advertising purposes related to this contest. Entrants also agree to receive communications via email or telephone from Perio in the Peninsula as a condition of entry.

Paddles submitted to the contest will be displayed publicly and/or online. We reserve the right to not display any paddle we feel is inappropriate for public display.

By submitting a paddle to the contest, it becomes the property of Perio in the Peninsula until such time as it is successfully auctioned to the highest bidder. A winning bid not only provides funds for our charities but also awards the paddle to the highest bid. If paddles do not receive auction bids they too become the property of Perio in the Peninsula and will be either donated or used to raise more funds through a future event, sale or auction. By entering, you certify that you are the creator of the paddle or the legal guardian of a youth entering. Perio in the Peninsula has the sole discretion to use or not use any paddles entered. In the case that we choose to not use a paddle, the creator will be contacted to arrange to have it returned. By entering, you consent to displaying your name, home town and information about your paddle publicly in regards to running this contest.

### **EXCLUDED PARTICIPANTS:**

Direct contest organizers are excluded from this contest. Perio in the Peninsula staff, partners, prize providers, and charity members are all eligible to participate. Amateur and professional artists are allowed to enter.
